IQAC

As per the guidelines of University Grants Commission of Bangladesh (UGC Bangladesh) every accredited institution should establish its own Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). This is essential to maintain the post-accreditation quality of the university. Quality enhancement being a continuous process, the IQAC becomes a part of the institution's system and works towards realization of the goals of quality enhancement and sustenance.

PRELUDE

Bangladesh's approach to devising a Quality Assurance Framework in higher education has eventuated in less than a decade. The framework provides criteria within which universities must operate and encompasses internal self-assessment review and monitoring besides external quality assurance, with the intrinsic goal of operationalising national protocols for a qualification framework. Based on the author's reflection regarding a programme self-assessment exercise as part of internal quality assurance procedure. We will agree that a robust internal quality assurance framework is indispensable to hasten the process of programme accreditation [1]. Bangladesh Government has already taken laudable initiatives, in this issue, to ensure quality education in HEIs.

1.0 HISTORY: FORMATION OF IQAC

In order to improve the quality of education at the tertiary level, the government of Bangladesh has taken several steps. The Higher Education Quality Enhancement Project (HEQEP) was one of such initiative. The University Grants Commission of Bangladesh (UGC) was acted as the the implementing agency of the project. The project was jointly financed by the World Bank and Government of Bangladesh, contributing 88 percent and 12 percent of the total cost respectively. Under HEQEP, a Quality Assurance Unit (QAU) was established at UGC in order to expedite the process of establishing quality culture at the universities. Towards targeting the establishment of quality culture at the universities, the Institutional Quality Assurance Cells (IQACs) have been established in all public and private universities. The QAU of UGC of Bangladesh provides guidance to the concerned IQACs, and oversee the activities including Self-Assessment (SA) of degree programs during the project period. IQAC, DIU has started its journey during 14 June, 2015 through signing the performance contract with University Grants Commission of Bangladesh (UGC).

Under the activities of IQAC, DIU following steps were followed:

- 1. Self-Assessment Process
- 2. External Peer Review Process
- 3. Post Self-Assessment Improvement Plan
- 4. Implementation Phase

Based on the following criteria, all SA Departments have completed the SA Exercise

- Criteria 1: Governance
- Criteria 2: Curriculum Content Design & Review
- Criteria-3: Student Admission, Progress and Achievements
- **Criteria 4: Physical Facilities**
- Criteria 5: Teaching Learning and Assessment
- Criteria 6: Student Support Services
- Criteria 7: Staff and Facilities
- Criteria 8: Research and Extension
- Criteria 9: Process Management & Continuous Improvement

Activities of Self-Assessment (SA) Committees:

Self-Assessment Committee (SAC): There is a three-member Self-Assessment Committee in each program offering the entity of the university. The Dean/Chairman/ Head of the program offering entity will form the Program SA Committee (PSAC) for the entity. The Head and two members of SAC shall be filled up by the interested, experienced, appropriately qualified senior faculty of the entity under assessment. The SAC will be formed and function for one year. During this one year period the SAC will conduct the self-assessment and facilitate the external peer review and prepare the improvement plan for further academic development. In addition, the SAC will oversee the QA related activities within the program offering entity and will make sure that all the QA activities undertaken by the IQAC and applicable for the entity are being implemented properly. The SAC in cooperation with IQAC will work to develop the QA culture within the entity.

Responsibilities for Self-Assessment: As it is the responsibility of the university to ensure quality in education, ultimately, the responsibility of self-assessment goes to the university authority. In order to promote the quality culture within the university, on behalf of the university, the IQAC of the university will take the prime responsibility to carry out the self-assessment exercise. However, as integral parts of the university system all the units of university have its specific responsibility relating to self-assessment.

Demonstration session on "Glimpses on DIU Blended Learning Center"

In presence of two distinguished members of Bangladesh Accreditation Council (BAC): Professor Dr. Sanjoy Kumar Adhikary, Member, Bangladesh Accreditation Council and Professor Dr. S M Kabir, Member, Bangladesh Accreditation Council, Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), DIU in association with HRDI, organized a special session on 'Glimpses on DIU Blended Learning Center' which was held on 22 July, 2020. These two dignitaries were invited to see the overall operation of DIU's integrated online platform, 'DIU Blended Learning Center'. During the pandemic (COVID 19), the higher education learning (with physical presence) becomes difficult and affected. But, DIU has managed very well to offer on-line (blended learning) to its student as DIU has almost decade experience in this domain.

Professor Dr. S.M. Mahbub UI Haque Majumder, Vice Chancellor (in-charge), and Pro Vice Chancellor, Treasurer, Registrar, All Deans, Associate Deans, Heads, AssociateHeads, Conveners and Members of Self-Assessment Committee of each SA Departments, Director, Additional Director, IQAC, team IQAC, and students were present at the session. In his welcome speech, Professor Dr. S.M. Mahbub UI Haque Majumder, Vice Chancellor (in-charge), and Pro Vice Chancellor has stressed on the importance and rationale of online/blended education system and also addressed the initiatives taken by DIU since long. After this, Senior Assistant Director, Mr. Khondker Mohammad Shah-Al-Mamun shared statistical representation on BLC.

DIU initiatives during pandemic: Case of Blended Learning Center
